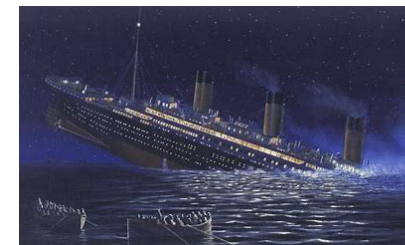


## Iceberg Ahead! History and Geography Knowledge Organiser - Term 2 - Donaldson



Key Vocabulary	
continent	A large area of <b>land</b> . Earth has 7 continents.
ocean	A huge area of <b>salt water</b> between continents.
iceberg	A huge chunk of <b>ice</b> floating in the ocean.
collision	When two or more objects <b>bump</b> into each other.
disaster	A <b>sudden</b> event causing a lot of <b>damage</b> or <b>suffering</b> .
lifeboat	A small <b>boat</b> that is carried on a ship for people to use to <b>escape</b> if the ship is in danger or sinking.
