
## <u>Great Britain! Geography Knowledge Organiser - Term 3 - Donaldson</u>

city	A city is a place with many streets and buildings where people live and work that is larger or more important than a town.	
village	A village is a place where people live that is smaller than a city or a town.	
physical features	Physical features are the natural features on the Earth's surface.	
human features	Human features are things that are made or built by humans.
