Speech and Language update

The NHS Extended Schools Service (ESS) was a service that had been available to schools in North Kent to provide speech and language support. As a school we had been able to buy in sessions from an NHS Speech and Language Therapist to support us in identifying and supporting children with speech, language and communication needs.

Due to reduced capacity within the team they are no longer able to offer this and sadly the service was closed down at the end of December 2022. We are currently seeking alternative arrangements but will continue to provide speech and language interventions for children within school. This will however no longer be under the guidance of a qualified Speech and Language Therapist. If you have any concerns about this please get in touch.
