

## Plants Knowledge Organiser – Year 1: Term 4

Key Science Vocabulary	
wild plants	Wild plants are plants that grow on their own in the wild.
garden plants	Garden plants are plants that people choose to grow in their gardens.
trees	A tree is a large woody plant.
evergreen	Evergreen trees keep their green leaves all year round, even in the winter! Cedar is an evergreen tree.
deciduous	Deciduous trees lose their leaves every year. Oak is a deciduous tree.

Previous Learning	
In EYFS	We learned to name and describe plants that we might find!

Parts of Plants	
root	Roots are attached to the soil and take in water and nutrients for the plant.
stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers.
trunk	A trunk is the main woody stem of a tree.
leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to help the plant to make its own food.
flowers	Flowers attract insects and birds.
fruit	Fruit has the plants seeds and is eaten by animals.

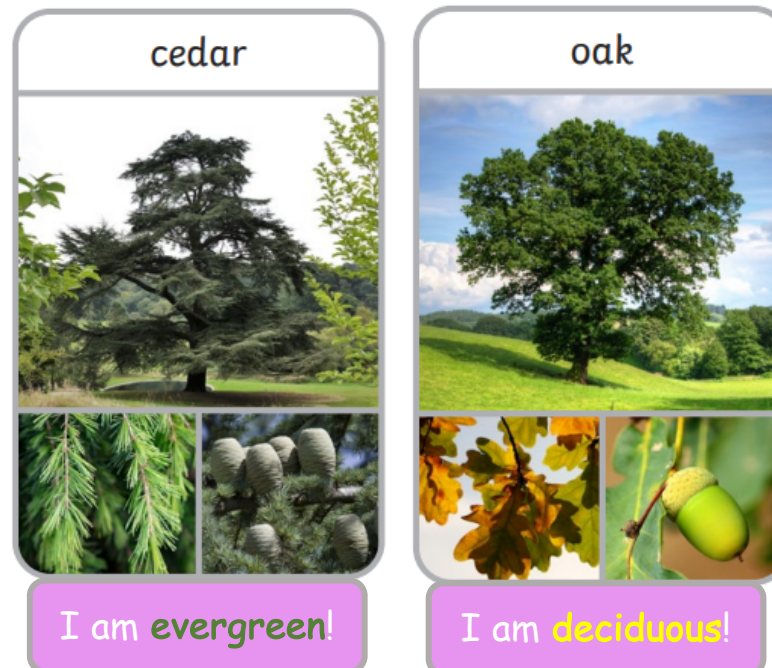
