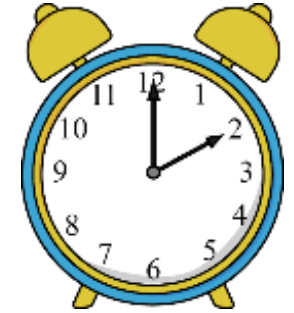




# Once Upon A Time - History Knowledge Organiser - Year 1: Term 4



Key Historic Vocabulary	
<b>old</b>	Something that is <b>old</b> has been around for many years.
<b>new</b>	Something that is <b>new</b> has not been around for very long.
<b>past</b>	The <b>past</b> is something that has already happened. Objects from the <b>past</b> are not used anymore.
<b>present</b>	The <b>present</b> is something that is happening now. Objects in the <b>present</b> are used today.
<b>artefact</b>	An <b>artefact</b> is an important historical object made by humans.
<b>photograph</b>	A <b>photograph</b> is a picture that has been taken on a camera.

<b>The Brothers Grimm</b>	The <b>Brothers Grimm</b> collected lots of old fairy tales and shared them with the world. They are two brothers from Germany called Jacob and Wilhelm. We will be learning about Hansel and Gretel this term.	
<b>Punch and Judy</b>	<b>Punch and Judy</b> is the most popular puppet show of all time. It is still performed now. Shows are often performed at fairs and by the seaside. It was first performed in England in 1662.
