Key Vocabulary	
<b>rainforest</b>	Thick forests found in wet areas of the world.
<b>equator</b>	An imaginary circle around the Earth dividing it into two equal parts - the Northern hemisphere and the Southern hemisphere.
<b>population</b>	The number of people living in a certain place.
<b>deforestation</b>	When humans cut down or burn down large areas of forests.
<b>climate</b>	The weather conditions in a certain place.
<b>habitat</b>	Places where animals or plants live.

<b>Amazon</b> 	The <b>Amazon</b> is the biggest rainforest in the world. It is located in South America with most of the <b>Amazon</b> rainforest in Brazil.
<b>Congo</b> 	The <b>Congo</b> is the second biggest rainforest in the world. It is located in Africa.
<b>Borneo</b> 	<b>Borneo</b> is the third largest island in the world and most of it is rainforest. <b>Borneo</b> is home to many rare creatures and plants.
