


## A Pirate's Life For Me! Knowledge Organiser - Term 6 - Donaldson



### Key Vocabulary

<b>continent</b>	A large solid area of land. Earth has seven continents.
<b>ocean</b>	A huge body of salt water. Earth has five oceans.
<b>desert island</b>	An island that is uninhabited.
<b>uninhabited</b>	A place that is not lived in by people.
<b>marooned</b>	To leave someone in a place that they cannot escape from.
<b>compass</b>	A tool for finding directions.
<b>compass points</b>	North, South, East and West.
<b>atlas</b>	A collection of maps.
