New class arrangements for September 2025

Next academic year, we will be changing the way our classes are structured. From September 2025, all pupils will be taught in separate year group classes (Year R, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6) rather than the split classes we currently have for Year 1/2 and Year 2/3. This decision means we require an additional teacher to join our team and so this week, we held interviews for a teaching post. We are pleased to inform you that Mrs Kaur, who is currently a trainee teacher in Year 4 (Rauf Class), has been appointed as a permanent member of staff. We are delighted that she will remain with us next year. I am sure you will join me in congratulating her on her success.



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Year 6 SATs week

A reminder that next week is Year 6 SATs week. These statutory national curriculum assessments cover English grammar, punctuation and spelling, reading, and mathematics. They are taken by all Year 6 pupils during Term 5 and are completed simultaneously in schools across the country. The results provide secondary schools with a clear picture of each child's strengths and next steps, helping to ensure the right support and challenge is in place as they move into Year 7.


