From next term, Aspens Services will be taking over our school catering provision. We're excited to introduce their fresh approach to school meals, along with a new three-week rolling menu starting from **2nd June**.

Important Updates:

- Sandwich choices will now include ham, cheese, or tuna. Egg and jam options will no longer be available.
- All sandwiches will be served with a fresh salad instead of tortilla chips.
- A salad bowl and bread will be available daily.
- Due to rising food and staffing costs, the price of a school meal will increase to £2.53 per day from 2nd June.

This does not affect children in Reception to Year 2 (Universal Infant Free School Meals) or those eligible for free school meals.

If your child has any allergies, dietary needs, or lifestyle requirements, please complete the **Alternative Menu Form** as soon as possible. Paper copies are also available from the School Office.

We look forward to welcoming this refreshed service and hope your children enjoy the updated menu. As always, we welcome your feedback on the changes.
