Classes for next year

Following my letter to you all earlier today, sharing the disappointing news of the delayed opening of our new school site on Crete Hall Road, we have taken the difficult decision to remain with split year group classes next year (due to the space at our current site). To avoid further disruption, the current split year group classes (Donaldson and Dahl) will move up to their next teacher within these classes. Year 1/2 will move to be a Year 2/3 class and current Year 2/3 will become a Year 3/4 class. This is to ensure consistency and coverage of the curriculum and to support a smoother transition for these pupils. This will result in us also having a Year R, Year 1, Year 5 and Year 6 class next year.
