local	relating or restricted to a particular area or one's neighbourhood
river	a large natural stream of water flowing in a channel to the sea, a lake, or another river.
map	a diagrammatic representation of an area of land or sea showing physical features, cities, roads, etc.
chronological	the arrangement of events or dates in the order of their occurrence.

Timeline

About 200,000 years ago	Known settlers next to the River Thames are suspected to date back this far
47 AD	Founded by the Romans, Londinium was declared the new capital of England.
1381	Gravesend granted sole right to ferry passengers to London via Thames.
1800s	Thames known for holiday destination and Gravesend becomes famous for it's pleasure gardens.
