Uniform

A reminder that pupils must wear correct school uniform at all times. This includes:

- Dark grey or black trousers or skirt or pinafore
- Flat black sensible school shoes (no boots please)
- Only plain hair bands should be worn in school colours (black, grey, white, blue).

Jewellery: Only **stud earrings** are allowed, **no hoops or dangly earrings**. They must be removed or taped for PE (tape provided by parents for the first six weeks after piercing). No hoop earrings, necklaces, or bracelets, unless for religious reasons. For children who attend swimming, the swimming baths state that no earrings are to be worn at all (no tape is allowed), therefore please ensure earrings are removed on swimming days.



PE Uniform

After discussions with staff, **children may come to school in their PE uniform** to maximise lesson time. This arrangement will be reviewed at the end of Term 2, as we value uniform for belonging, health, and safety.

PE uniform includes:

- black or navy shorts or tracksuit bottoms
- black or navy jumper
- suitable trainers or plimsolls
- Rosherville logoed PE t-shirt from MAPAC, a plain house-coloured t-shirt OR a plain white t-shirt.

Other items are not considered PE kit; if worn, we will ask for a change of clothes to be bought into school. If not provided, children will use items from our freshly laundered spare uniform box.

Attendance

Thank you to all our families for supporting good attendance this week – we reached **96.4%** as a whole school, which is fantastic and makes a real difference to the children's learning.

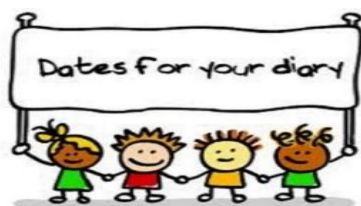
