### **Driving near school**

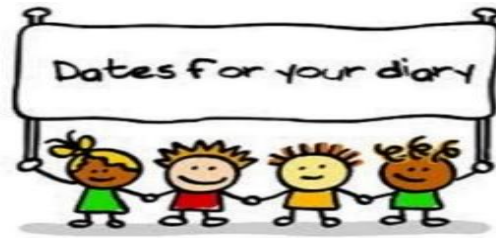
