### **Important Reminder: Road Safety Around School**

We have recently had reports of some dangerous driving around the school. Please remember that U-turns should not be made on London Road, particularly near the zebra crossing. Drivers must also avoid parking on the zig-zag lines outside the school. Local councils can issue motorists with penalty charge notices (PCN) for waiting, stopping or parking on zigzags if restrictions are in place. Car users should also avoid mounting the kerb, remain vigilant for pedestrians and travel at an appropriate speed **at all times. Please slow down as you approach the zebra crossing and take extra care during busy drop-off and collection times.** The safety of our children, families and local residents depends on everyone driving responsibly.

The class with the best attendance this week is Zephaniah class with 97.5% – Well done!




