Attendance Matters

Did you know that missing just one day every two weeks may not seem like much, but it quickly adds up? Nationally, children who are persistently absent (miss more than 19 days in a school year) are significantly less likely to achieve expected standards in reading, writing and maths by the end of primary school.

The class with the best attendance this week is **Rauf class with 98.6%** – Well done!

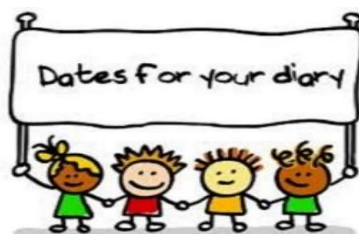
