The class with the best attendance this week is Zephaniah class with an excellent level of attendance at 99.4%!

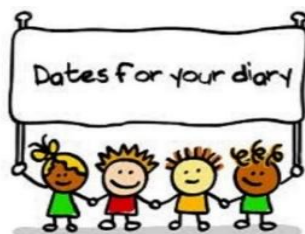


Term 4 Activities
