As we look ahead to next term, we encourage everyone to continue aiming high—every day in school counts!

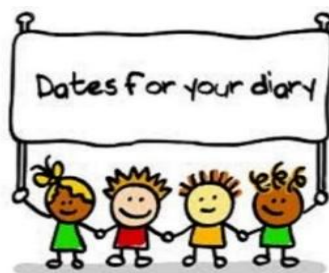
