The class with the best attendance this week is Morpurgo with 97.7% - Well done, what a great start to the Summer term!

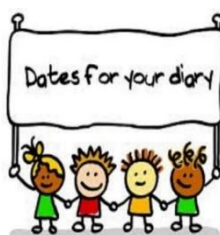
