Congratulations to both Morpurgo and Rauf classes who both had attendance of over 99% this week.



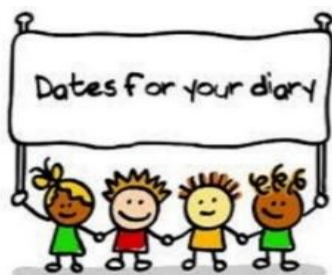
