Congratulations to Morpurgo class for having 100% attendance and 100% punctuality from Monday – Thursday this week!

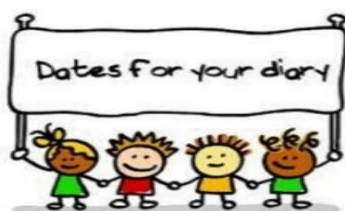
