Dear Parents/Carers,

**Congratulations to Morpurgo class for having the highest attendance this week with 97%.**

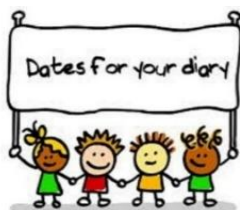
