Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to this week's newsletter. It has been wonderful to see the excitement and positive energy across school as we head into another busy week. With the start of the World Cup, there is a real buzz and sense of community as children enjoy sharing their enthusiasm for the tournament.

Uniform Expectations

As the weather warms up, please remember our uniform expectations:

- Children should wear grey or black school trousers, shorts, culottes, skirts or pinafores with a pale blue school polo shirt.
- Cycling shorts, hot pants, leggings and other non-uniform shorts/trousers are not permitted. Knee-length cycling shorts may be worn under skirts/dresses if required.
- Summer uniform: blue and white check gingham dress. Two-piece gingham outfits and short, layered or frilled skirts (ra-ra) skirts are not part of our uniform. Short/dungaree-style gingham dresses are permitted.
- PE kit: plain black or navy-blue PE shorts. Knee-length cycling shorts may also be worn for PE.
- Footwear: school shoes should be worn daily. On PE days, plain dark trainers may be worn.
- Umbrellas should not be brought into school for safety reasons

The weather is forecast to be lovely next week, so please ensure sunscreen has been applied before school where appropriate and that your child has a named sun hat/cap for outdoor activities. We will be taking precautions in school to ensure child remain as cool as possible during the warmer weather. Thank you for your continued support in helping our children look smart and take pride in their school uniform.

Pupils who wish to have more than 1 sponge should bring their donation in a clearly labelled envelope or bag on the day of the event and give it to their teacher.
