Dear Parents/Carers,

Thank you for helping us keep everyone safe, comfortable and ready to enjoy their learning. As a reward, all children and staff were treated to an ice pole this afternoon.

New Classes and Transition Day

On Friday 3rd July, we will be holding our transition day for pupils in Years R–5. During this day, children will spend time with their new class teacher and begin to find out more about what life will be like next year. Although they will not be moving into their new classrooms just yet, this will be a valuable opportunity for them to ask questions, build relationships and feel more prepared for the year ahead.

Over the past few weeks, we have been taking part in special assemblies to help us think about the changes ahead and how we can approach change with confidence, courage and a positive mindset.

From September, our classes will move to single year groups rather than the mixed year groups that some children are currently in. Also, congratulations to the Rauf for topping our Attendance League Table this week!



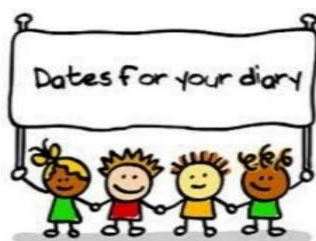
